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# Economically Active Population Survey in July 2024

### <Economically active population and labor force participation rate>

- The economically active population marked 29.594 million persons in July, which grew 102 thousand persons or 0.3% year-on-year.
- The labor force participation rate stood at 64.9% in July, down 0.1%p year-on-year.

## <Employed persons and employment to population ratio>

- The number of employed persons totaled 28.857 million persons in July, which went up 172 thousand persons or 0.6% year-on-year.
- The employment to population ratio recorded 63.3% in July, up 0.1%p year-on-year.

# <Unemployed persons and unemployment rate>

- The number of unemployed persons totaled 737 thousand people in July, which decreased 70 thousand persons or 8.7% year-on-year.
- The unemployment rate marked 2.5% in July, down 0.2%p year-on-year.

### <Economically inactive population>

 The economically inactive population totaled 15.996 million people in July, increasing 89 thousand persons or 0.6% year-on-year.
