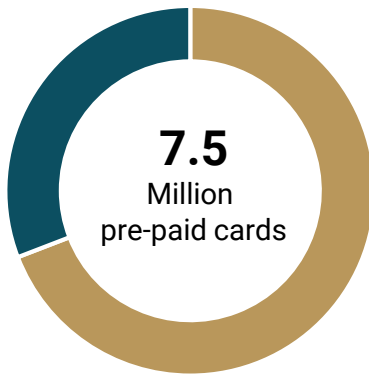

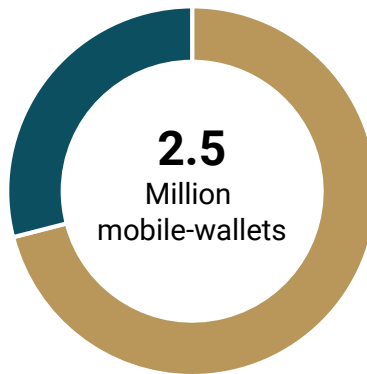

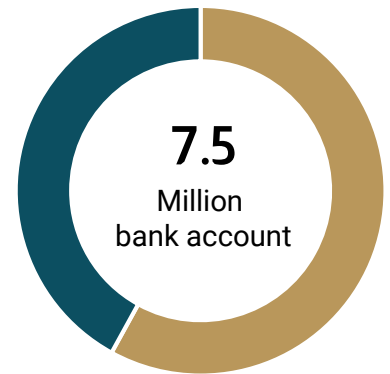

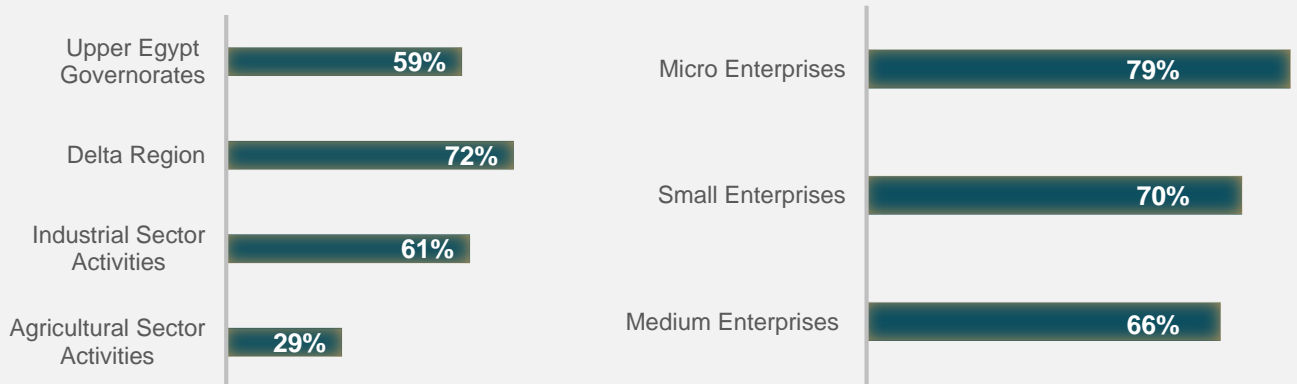

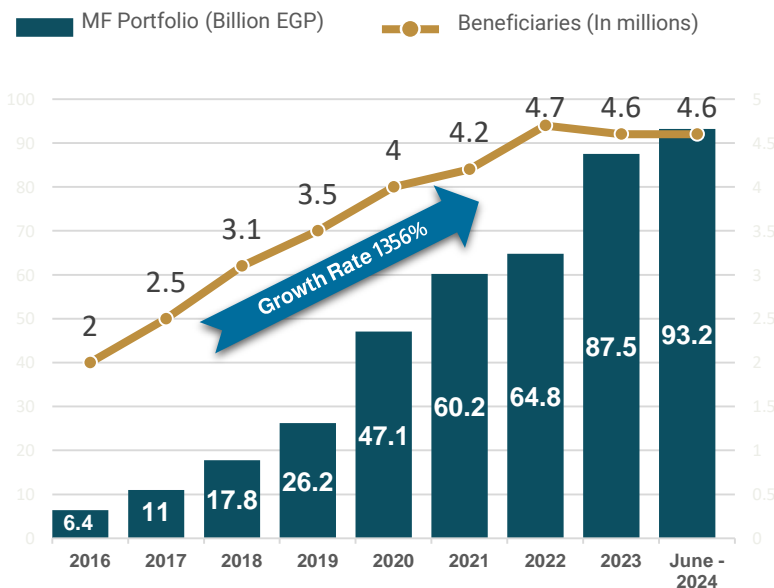

(From December 2015 to June 2024)

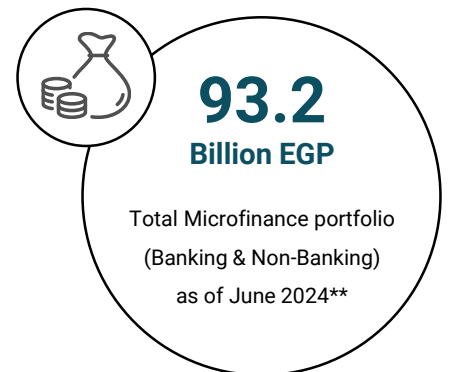
Key Growth Indicators of Banks' MSMEs Portfolios (December 2020 – June 2024)*
